
THE PRAYER OVER THE FIRE AND LIGHTING OF THE PASCHAL CANDLE





The precepts of the LORD are right, rejoicing the heart; The command of the LORD is clear, enlightening the eye.


The fear of the LORD is pure, enduring forever; The ordinances of the LORD are true, all of them just.


The Risen Christ




