

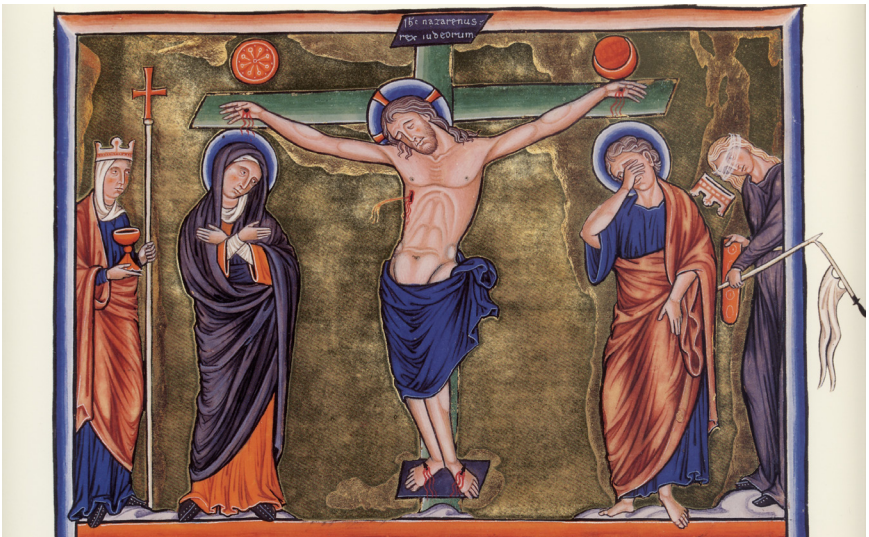

All: Come, let us wor - ship.

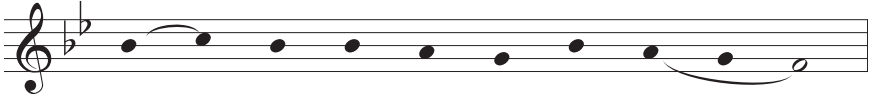
