The Pastor's Corner



Dear sisters and brothers,

Greetings!

The Gospel passage from John today indicates that this was the third time that Jesus "revealed" himself to his Apostles since he was raised from the dead.

I have some other "revelations" to share with you during this month of May:

- 1. Our Construction Committee has recommended that we limit the use of the school building due to energy concerns and high utility bills. The school building has three groups that utilize this property: Adult Education, 12 step groups, and the Food Pantry that serves the poor on Tuesdays, Fridays and Saturdays. It was agreed to only open the school building on those three days including adult education and 12 step programs. We met with all 12 step programs and they agreed to this new format. The three day shared space use begins officially on Thursday, May 1. More information about the school building will be shared at a future gathering.
- 2. We will remember all mothers and mother figures during Mother's Day weekend May 10 and 11. Mother figures include grandmothers, godmothers, women who adopt children, and women who act with maternal responsibility. At the end of all weekend liturgies, we will invite all mothers and mother figures to come up to the sanctuary for a special blessing and receive a white carnation. During the universal prayer, a special intercession for all deceased mothers and mother figures will be offered with a pregnant pause. We will remember and honor both the living and the deceased.
- 3. On May 18th, we will celebrate Franciscan (OFM) vocations to the priesthood and religious life.
- 4. Members of the Synod Committee/ Parish Council will be introduced at the Memorial Day weekend Masses.

May will be a busy month for our beloved parish!




MOTHER'S DAY REMEMBRANCES 2025
