The Pastor's Corner

Dear sisters and brothers,

Greetings!

The readings this weekend stress the importance of humility in public service. The first reading from the Book of Sirach emphasizes the importance of humility pursuing wisdom in the public arena "Humble yourself the more." This message is echoed in today's Gospel passage from St. Luke" but the one who humbles himself will be exalted."



With all humility, I would like to share with you two necessary financial points of information. First, we are introducing "The Father Mychal Judge, OFM Building Fund" at all the Masses this weekend. The purpose of this special fund is to raise funds for renovations, repairs, and replacements of our three buildings: our Church; our parish house and our school building. These funds are restricted and are for the exclusive use to take care of our three buildings. More information will be provided in a special insert that will be inside the bulletins and adorned on the walls of the church and the rest of our property this weekend.

Second, the Archdiocese of New York has asked us to promote an Increased Offertory Campaign at all weekend and possibly weekday Masses. Our collections are slowly rising back to our pre-Covid 19 status of February 2020. The Archdiocese believes this campaign led by the pastor will increase the offertory collection by at least 15%. I will refer to this effort at weekend Masses in late September and early October of this year.

Humility in service is always welcome in any day. In fact, it leads to kindness. The famous French Catholic writer Blaise Pascal once wrote "Kind words do not cost much. Yet they accomplish much."
